



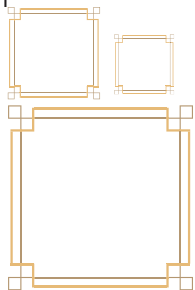
The Word Gallery



1. Explore your house as if it's the first time you have ever been there. Make notes of everything you see, list all the words and names of everything.

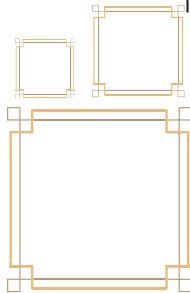
2. Also list all the words that you associate with the main word
i.e.

Chair - grey - cushion - comfy -
sit - relax - read - nap.



3. Once you've written down all the words you can sort them into categories, such as:

Colours, Funny Sounding Words, Names,
Words I Love, Words I Don't Like



4. Now it's time to open your Word Gallery and host your first exhibition. Look carefully at all your collected words and decide which ones you would most like to share.

5. Using the card from your bag cut each piece in half and write your word on it as big as you can, then decoarte each card and word with a drawn frame - use the pencils from your bag.

6. Now position your collected words on a table or window ledge and invite your family to come and view your word gallery. For the added gallery feel you could include a short introduction for each word to say why it's in your exhibition!
